This application updates the status codes on Sales Order lines.

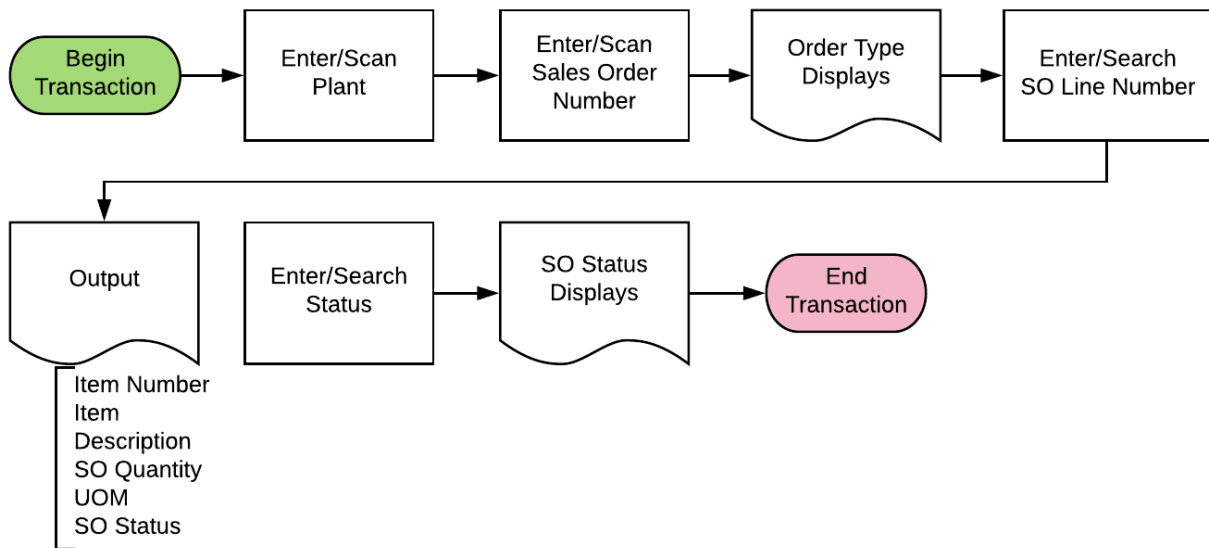

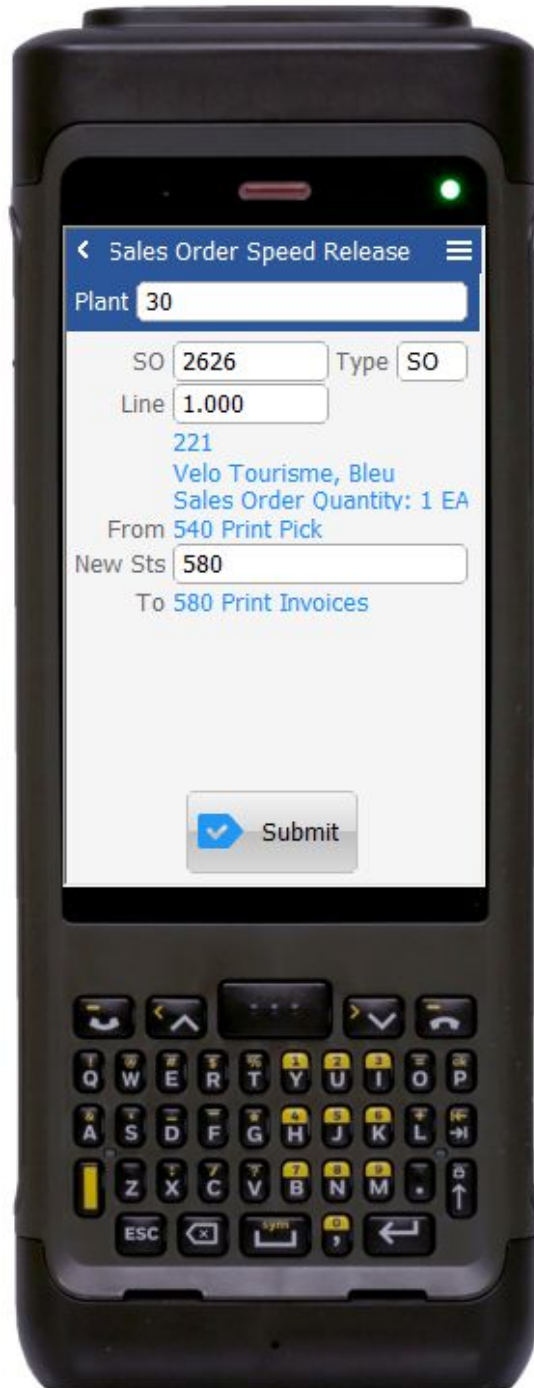
This document describes the business workflow and technical information used in this application.

## JD Edwards: Sales Order (SO) - Speed Status Update Workflow



## FSOSU0100 SO – Speed Status Update

This application updates the status codes on Sales Order lines.



### Description of Workflow

First the user scans, enters, or searches for a plant if one does not default from the user profile.

Next, the user scans, enters, or searches for the sales order number in the SO field.

The order type is retrieved and the default displays in the Type field.

Next the user will enter or search and select the line number.

The item number, item description, sales order quantity, primary UOM, and the current sales order status display below the line number.

The user now enters or searches and selects a new status for this sales order line.

The new status displays in the To field, and the Submit button appears.

The **Submit** button sends this transaction to JDE and then the form will reset.

The arrow in the upper left corner of page 1 takes the user back to the menu.
