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Workflow Details (Page 1)

First the user scans, enters, or searches for asset books.

The book description displays.

Next the user is given the option to scan, enter, or search the asset tag name/ID.

The number of unit quantities associated with the asset displays.

The current account, location, and employee for the asset display.

The user taps the **Continue** button which takes the user to page 2.

The arrow in the upper left corner exits the application and returns the user to the menu.

Page 2 displays.

The asset tag name/ID displays at the top of the screen.

The user enters the new account, location, or employee that the tag will be assigned to.

Next the user enters the asset unit quantity being transferred.

Finally, the user taps the **Save** button.

The **Save** button uploads the transaction to save the transfer in the EBS system.

The arrow in the upper left corner takes the user back the user back to the prior screen.
