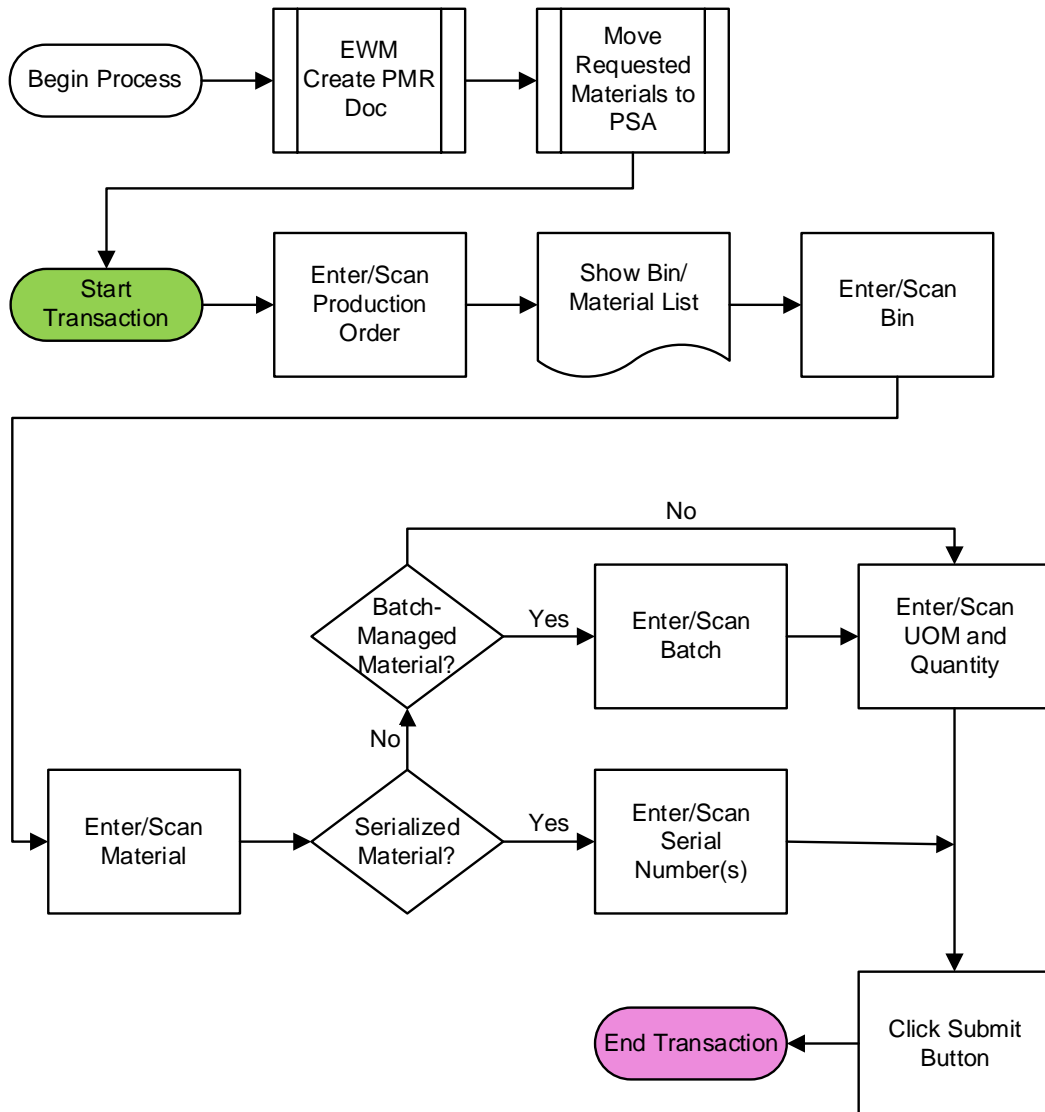
RFgen provides its customers SAP-validated, ready-to-use suites of Open Source applications and a development environment that can be used to create new apps or to modify existing apps.

SAP: Extended Warehouse Management (EWM) – Issue to Production



FEWIP0200 – Issue to Production



This application is used to issue to materials to a production order.

Description of Workflow

Before starting the **Issue to Production** application, the SAP EWM system generates a **Production Material Request (PMR)** document. This is followed by a **Move Requested Materials to PSA** (production supply area) task in SAP.

Once this task is done, the user can begin work in the **Issue to Production** application on their mobile device/desktop.

First, the user scans, enters, or searches for a production order in the Order field.

A list of the bins and materials at the production staging area displays. The user enters, scans, or searches for a bin in the Bin field.

The user scans, or enters, or searches for a material in the Materials field. The material must be in the entered bin. If the material is batch-controlled, the Batch field will be visible. If the material is serialized, the Serial field will be visible and the UOM and Quantity fields will be invisible.

If the Batch field is visible, the user scans, enters, or searches for a batch number that is assigned to the material specified.

If UOM and Quantity fields are visible, the user enters the Unit of Measure and Quantity to Issue. The Open Order Quantity to issue and the Maximum Available Quantity will be displayed. User may enter a quantity that is less than the Max Available Quantity.

If the Serial field is visible, the user scans, enters, or searches for serial number. The serial number must be in the entered bin and associated with the entered material. The user may continuously scan serial numbers as many as wanted. The scanned serial numbers will be shown in the list.

The user taps the **Submit** button. The **Submit** button will post the issued material to SAP. After the submission, the App reset and return to Bin field for user to issue other materials.

The arrow in the upper left corner undoes the current entry and moves the cursor back to the previous prompt until you reach the menu.
