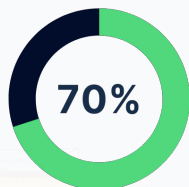

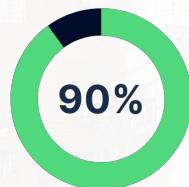

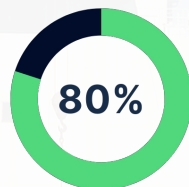

Navigating Choppy Waters

As Eastern looked to streamline operations, Dustin Rhodes, the new Inventory Control Supervisor, quickly realized the challenges firsthand. He saw that the company's reliance on manual data entry created significant bottlenecks. Inventory errors were delaying projects, and time-intensive processes were draining resources. Common mistakes, like inaccurate inventory

records in the ERP system, compounded the issue. Dustin also found that training new employees on outdated systems only made matters worse. It was clear that to cut through these inefficiencies, Eastern needed a solution that could deliver faster, more accurate results.

Setting Sail with Mobile Barcoding Technology

Smooth Sailing Ahead

The impact was immediate and profound:

Faster Receiving

Processing time for receiving materials was reduced by 50-70%, with some facilities completing the process in less than a day. Dustin reported, "We saw one of the lowest times ever to receive material into a warehouse." Previously, the process could take anywhere from one to two days, depending on various factors. Now, in some cases, the task is completed in just three-quarters of a day, significantly reducing the effort and time required.

Streamlined PO Receipts

The time required for PO receipts dropped by 90%, from an average of five minutes to mere seconds. This dramatic reduction is achieved by allowing employees to perform transactions at the point of activity — directly on the warehouse floor or even at their desks, eliminating wasted walking time, significantly increasing productivity.

Improved Employee Morale

Equipping employees with efficient tools had a significant impact on morale, especially from the perspective of those who had hands-on experience with the previous processes. As Bob noted, "Giving them the tools to do what they need to do, it's just had a huge impact morale-wise." The ease of use of the new system reduced frustration and simplified daily tasks, making the work environment much more positive and productive. Even employees who were initially resistant to technology found themselves embracing RFgen, thanks to its user-friendly design and the noticeable

improvements it brought to their daily routines. There were "literally zero complaints" about the new system, which was a major win—particularly given the tough working conditions in the shipyards, including extreme heat and humidity.

Increased Inventory Accuracy

RFgen drastically reduced manual keypunching errors, leading to more reliable inventory data and bolstering confidence in the system. Further, improved visibility within inventory management helped avoid the previous issues of incorrect quantities and "hot racks," where requested materials were not actually in stock. Bob explained, the company has "the confidence that we have now a system that'll do it versus some of the manual keypunching errors that you see that go along with that."

Projected Labor Cost Savings

In a challenging job market where hiring and training new employees can be time-consuming and costly, RFgen helped Eastern Shipbuilding streamline operations and reduce headcount needs. By optimizing processes and maximizing resources, they were able to complete projects without the need for backfills.
