This application is used to transfer fixed assets from one location to another location, using either the asset or unit number.

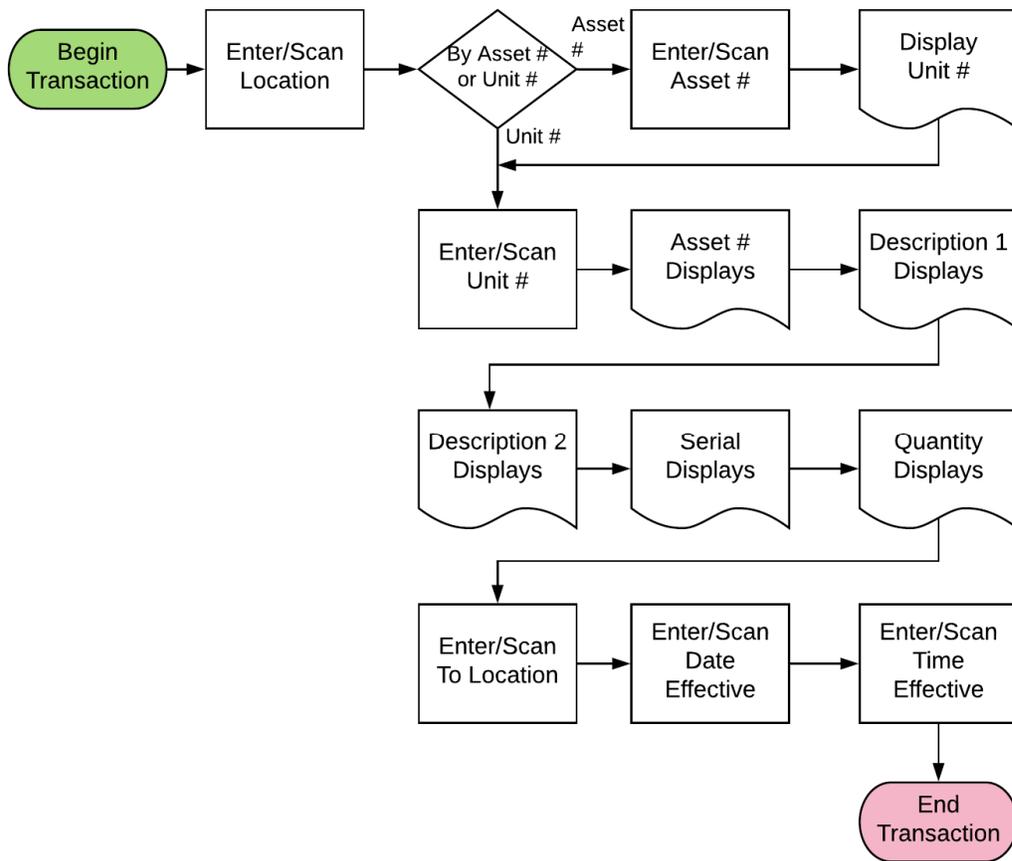

This document describes the business workflow and technical information used in this application.

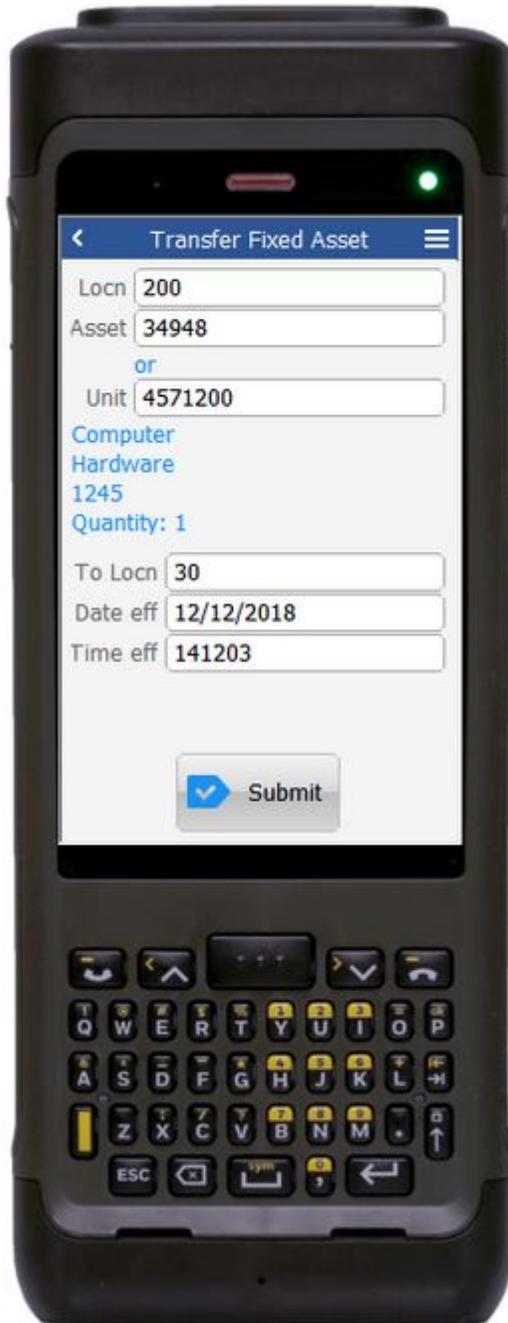


Fixed Asset Location Transfer Workflow



FFATR0100 FA – Fixed Asset Location Transfer

This application transfers fixed assets (FA) from one location to another using either the asset or unit number, and updates the Location tracking table (F1204).



Description of Workflow

First the user scans, enters, or searches the location where the fixed asset is being transferred from.

The user scans, enters, or searches either the Asset ID or the Unit ID. The system will default/display the missing value if its setup in the Asset master file.

Upon entry of the asset, description 1, description 2, serial number, and quantity display.

The To location (To Locn) is the location where the fixed asset is being transferred to.

The user enters the effective date (Date eff) of the transfer, and the effective time (Time eff).

The time must be entered in the 24 -hour time format as `hhmmss`.

Note that all counts utilize the item's JDE Primary Unit of Measure.

The **Submit** button sends the transaction to JDE for asset disposal.

The arrow in the upper left corner takes the user back to the menu.
